#### What is Van Mahotsay?

Every year, India celebrates Van Mahotsav during the first week of July. In India, people commemorate Van Mahotsav by planting trees. ## **History of Van Mahotsav**

Dr. K.M. Munshi, the Union Minister of Agriculture and Food planned and launched Van Mahotsav, as a national event in 1950. The origin of the concept of Van Mahotsav is credited to M.S. Randhawa, a botanist from Punjab who, in 1947, arranged a week-long tree planting event that drew several well-known individuals from July 20–27.

India celebrates Van Mahotsav, a tree-planting holiday, to emphasize the cultural and environmental value of its woods, which are revered in many regions of the country rather than being only a resource. Van Mahotsav has been observed yearly since 1950 with the goals of increasing India's forest cover, planting more trees, and raising awareness of the value of planting trees for the future.
