For his great success in the field of science in India, Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman had been awarded and honored with the Nobel Prize in Physics in the year 1930. To honor this event, 28th of February is observed as a National Science Day in India by the National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC).
