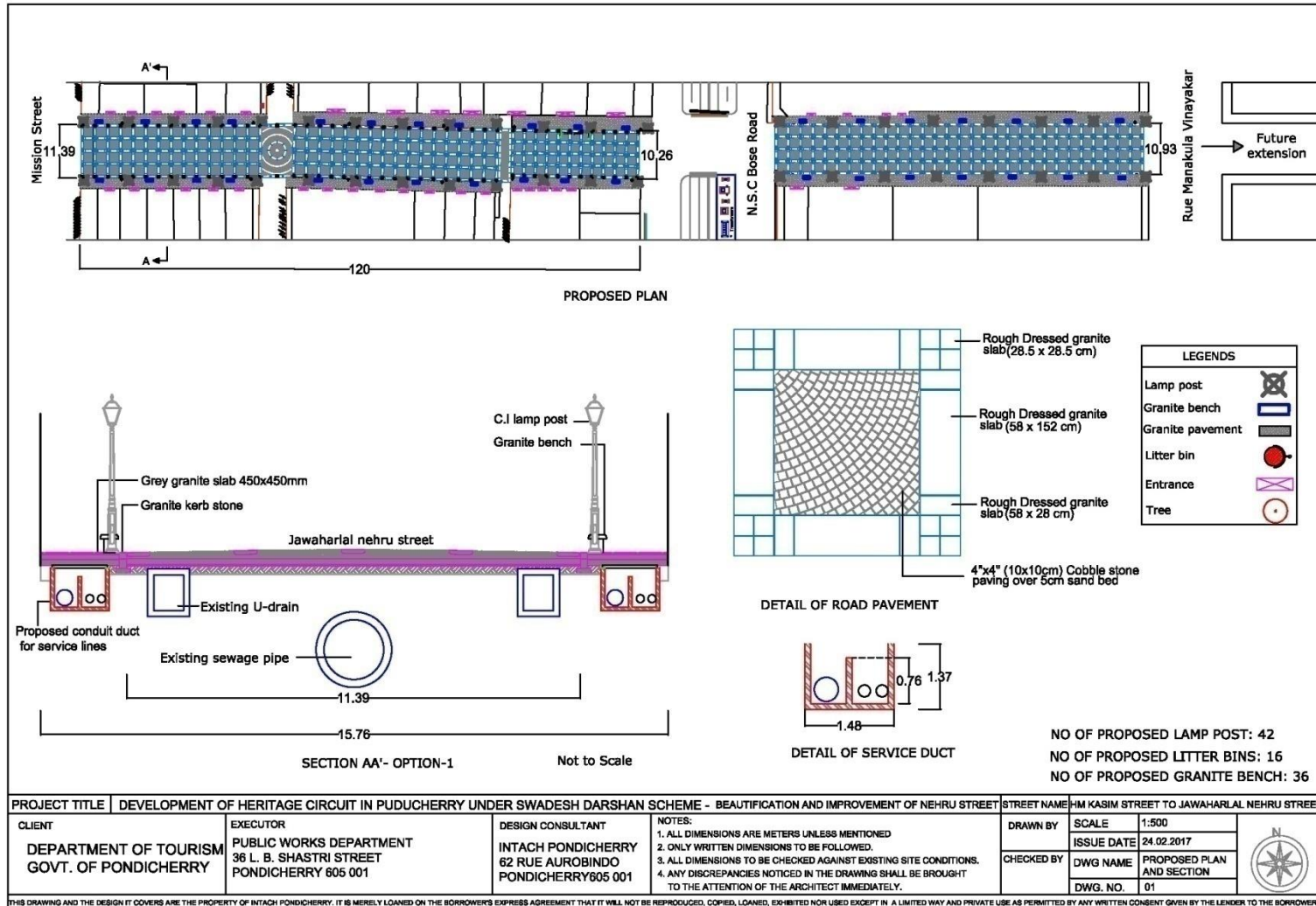

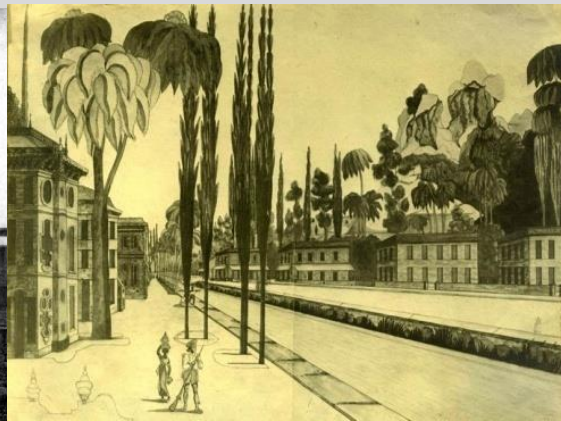
Beautification and improvement of Jawaharlal Nehru Street



Beautification of Grand Canal

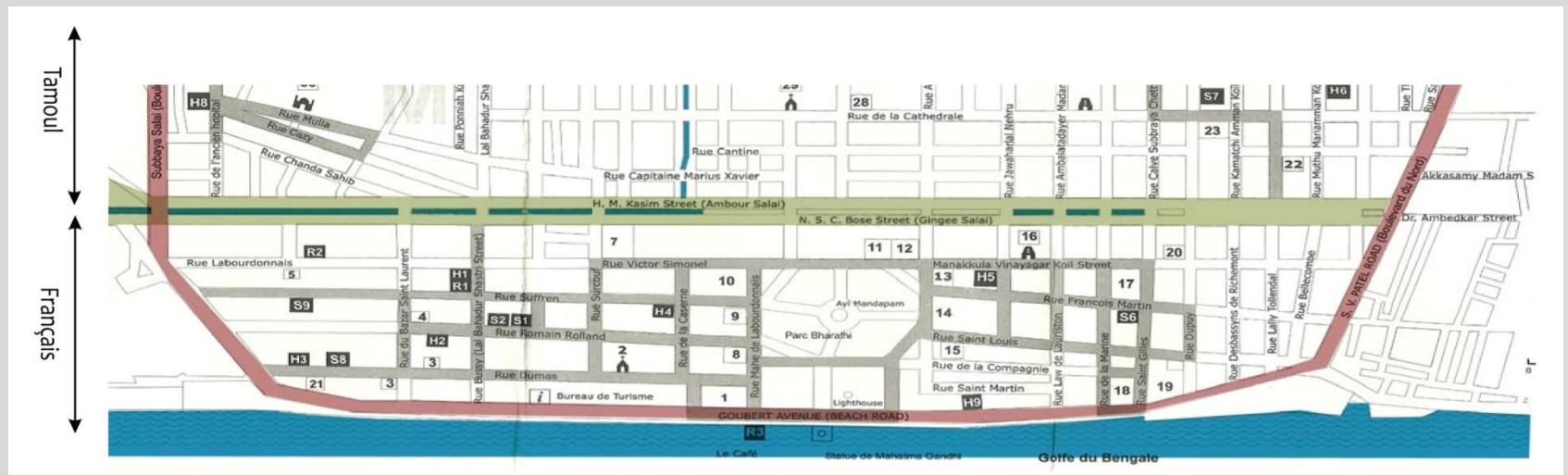


Grand canal was built around 1765 and divided the French and Tamil town.
