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### Agenda Item No. 1: Review of the status of implementation of Coastal Regulation Zone Notification, 2011 in Puducherry

A consultation meeting with the various Departments to discuss the issues related to implementation of Coastal Regulation Zone Notification (CRZ), 2011 in Puducherry U.T. was earlier held on 24.02.2011 under the Chairmanship of Development Commissioner. The various actions to be taken up by the line Departments on implementation of the CRZ Notification, 2011 were discussed in detail in the meeting. It was decided that the Departments concerned shall adhere to the following action points, roles and responsibilities and time schedules for implementing the CRZ, 2011 Notification in effective manner:

MoEF has issued an Office Memorandum dated 24.02.2011 to all the State / UT CZMAs, wherein CZMAs are required to carry out the following:

- a) To issue Direction under Section 5 of the EP Act, 1986 to all Municipal Bodies, industrial units, Ports, Thermal Power Units, Oil and Gas Exploration, Companies, Coastal Mining Bodies, Owners of the Boat Houses and Aqua Culture Units to stop discharging untreated effluent / disposal of solid wastes in the coastal and marine areas.
- b) A comprehensive plan involving reputed scientific institutions shall be prepared for identification for treatment of sewage generated from the coastal towns and cities. The plan shall include treatment facilities and disposal mechanism of the treated effluents.
- c) Based on the comprehensive plan which shall be prepared within one year from the date of receipt of the MoEF letter, dated 24.02.2011, the Authority shall implement the plan in phased manner in consultation with stake holders.

### Agenda Item No. 2: Identification of Violations under CRZ Notification, 1991:

MoEF has issued directions under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 vide corrs. dt. 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2011 to all State/UT CZMAs directing all the States/UTs CZMAs to identify the violations of Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) Notification, 1991 within a period of four months and initiate action under the EP Act, 1986 on the identified violations within four months thereafter. It was also directed that the State/UT CZMAs should upload the relevant details of these identified violations and action taken on the violations on their websites which would be updated every fortnight.

DSTE has informed the Ministry of Environment and Forests during the meeting held at MoEF on 10<sup>th</sup> February, 2011 that identification of Coastal Regulation Zone violations within a time frame of 4 months would be difficult and it was requested that the time limit for identification of all violations of CRZ Notification, 1991 may be extended for a period of one year. It was also mentioned that once the District Level Committees specified under CRZ Notification, 2011 is constituted to assist the PCZMA for enforcement and monitoring the task of identification of CRZ violations, initiation of action could be expedited.

The following actions have been initiated at present:

- i) The District Collectors of Puducherry & Karaikal have been requested to send a list of suitable candidates for nomination as the members of the District Level Committee vide letter dated 26.05.2011
- ii) The Chief Town Planner has been requested to identify all the constructions that are in violation of the CRZ Notification, 1991 within the Puducherry U.T. and intimate the details to this Authority so as to take necessary action, vide letter dated 14.07.2011

#### Remarks:

- This proposal was earlier discussed in the 24<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Puducherry i) Coastal Zone Management Authority held on 25.10.2010 as per the provisions of CRZ Notification, 1991. The Authority observed that the proposed site does not fall under Coastal Regulation Zone as per the Puducherry Coastal Zone Management Plan approved by MoEF. However since the salinity values determined in the Arsalar River abutting the proposed site is 28 ppt and the width of the river is 60 meters the proposed site would fall under Coastal Regulation Zone as per the CRZ Notification, 1991. The Authority observed that the proposal is a foreshore requiring activity as fish landing facility is proposed to directly bring the fishes to the market from the nearby Fishing Harbour. The Authority observed that this is significant rehabilitation project for the Tsunami affected fisher folks of Karaikal Region. Therefore the Authority decided to recommend the proposal to Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India for Clearance, as the project cost exceeds Rs. 5 Crore. Accordingly the proposal was recommended to MoEF for CRZ clearance vide Lr. dated 09.11.2010.
- ii) Meanwhile the CRZ Notification, 1991 has been replaced by the CRZ Notification, 2011 on 06.01.2011.
- Subsequently, the proposal was discussed in the 97<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Expert Appraisal Committee of MoEF for Building / Construction Projects / Township and Area Development Projects, Coastal Regulation Zone, Infrastructure Development and Miscellaneous projects held on 14th -15th February, 2011. The Committee deferred the proposal since, as per the Coastal Regulation Zone Notification, 2011, this project requires clearance from State Authority.

Hence, placed before the Authority for a decision.

- i) This proposal was earlier discussed in the 24<sup>th</sup> meeting of PCZMA held on 25.10.2010 as per the provisions of CRZ Notification, 1991. The Authority decided to recommend the proposal to Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India for Clearance, as the project cost exceeds Rs. 5 Crore. Accordingly, the proposal was recommended to the Director, IA-III, MoEF, GoI for issue of CRZ Clearance vide this office letter dated 05.11.2010.
- ii) Meanwhile the CRZ Notification, 1991 has been replaced by the CRZ Notification, 2011 on 06<sup>th</sup> January 2011.
- iii) This proposal was discussed in the 95th Meeting of the Expert Appraisal Committee of MoEF for Building/Construction Projects/Township and Area Development Projects, Coastal Regulation Zone, Infrastructure Development and Miscellaneous projects held on 18th to 20th January, 2011. The Committee deferred the proposal since, as per the Coastal Regulation Zone Notification, 2011, this project requires clearance from State Authority.

Hence, placed before the Authority for a decision.

## Agenda Item No 5: CRZ Clearance for proposed housing layout at R.S. No. 9/4, Bund Road, Uchimedu Revenue Village, Bahour Commune Panchayat, Puducherry by Thiru. C. Chinnasamy

MS-PPA has requested for the views of PCZMA on the proposal for a housing layout at R.S. No. 9/4, Bund Road, Uchimedu Revenue Village, Bahour Commune Panchayat, Puducherry by Thiru. C. Chinnasamy.

#### Remarks:

The R.S. No. 9/4 of Uchimedu Revenue Village in which the proposed site falls is not covered under CRZ as per the existing Puducherry Coastal Zone Management Plan. It is about 4 kms away from the sea. The site is facing Road on the Northern side and surrounded by Agricultural lands on South and West. On the Eastern side a small irrigation water canal is present. This is not a tidal influenced water body. Water is present in this canal only when the surplus water from the upper tanks is discharged. There was no flow in the canal during inspection done by DSTE officials on 08.07.2011.

Hence placed before the Authority for decision.

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
