Agenda Item No. 1: Status Review of implementation of Coastal Regulation Zone Notification, 2011 in Puducherry

The CRZ Notification, 2011 was published by MoEF, GoI on 06.01.2011. Subsequently a consultation meeting with the various Departments to discuss the issues related to implementation of Coastal Regulation Zone Notification (CRZ), 2011 in Puducherry U.T. was held on 24.02.2011 under the Chairmanship of Development Commissioner. The various actions to be taken up by the line Departments on implementation of the CRZ Notification, 2011 were discussed in detail in the meeting. The action points, roles and responsibilities and time schedules for implementing the CRZ, 2011 Notification in effective manner was finalized in the meeting. This was again reviewed in the 26th PCZMA meeting held on 21.07.2011 & 27th PCZMA meeting held on 07.11.2012 and time frame was fixed for the line Departments to complete their tasks. It was decided to review the implementation of the decision taken, in the next PCZMA meeting. An interdepartmental review meeting was held in the chamber of Director- DSTE on 07.03.2013 and the line Departments were requested to expedite action. - 9. MoEF has issued an Office Memorandum dated 24.02.2011 to all the State / UT CZMAs, wherein CZMAs are required to carry out the following:
 - i) To issue Direction under Section 5 of the EP Act. 1986 to Bodies, Municipal industrial units, Ports, Thermal Power Units, Oil and Gas Exploration, Companies, Coastal Mining Bodies, Owners of the Boat Houses and Aqua Culture Units to stop discharging untreated effluent disposal of solid wastes in the coastal and marine areas
 - ii) A comprehensive plan involving reputed scientific institutions shall be prepared for identification for treatment of sewage from the generated coastal towns and cities. The plan shall include treatment facilities and disposal mechanism of the treated effluents.
 - iii) Based on the comprehensive plan which shall be prepared within one year from the date of receipt of the MoEF letter, dated

An application has been received from Executive Engineer – PWD seeking CRZ Clearance for re-construction of two culverts in Vaithikuppam Road, Puducherry. The salient features of the proposal are stated below:

Construction of Culverts in CRZ is not listed under prohibited activities mentioned at Section 3 of the Notification. It is therefore a permissible activity. Under section 8, subsection III. CRZ-III – A. (iii) (j) it is explicitly stated that construction of dispensaries, schools, public rain shelter, community toilets, bridges, roads, provision of facilities for water supply, drainage, sewerage, crematoria, cemeteries and electric sub-station which are required for the local inhabitants may be permitted on a case to case basis by CZMA in the No Developmental Zone (between 200 to 500 meters) in CRZ III. Such a clear statement is not given in the Notification for CRZ II. But however since construction of Bridges and Roads are permitted in the No Development Zone of CRZ itself by the Coastal Zone Management Authority it implies that in the less restricted CRZ II area the same can be permitted by the the Coastal Zone Management Authority.

xi)	Any other details	 The above two minor bridges / culverts were constructed during French Regime in 1954. PWD has stated that the beams of the Bridge have cracked due to tidal effects of the sea and reinforcement is also corroding. Besides the abutment walls and piers have started cracking. Hence it is proposed to reconstruct the culvert. The project is funded by World Bank under Coastal Risk Reduction Project.

PPA was requested to issue directions to stop the work since PCZMA was not reconstituted during that time. PPA issued notice to stop work on 05.03.2012 and compliance report for stopping the work was submitted by Project Proponent on 27.03.2012.

Agenda Item No. 6: CRZ Clearance for M/s. Seamate Ice plant proposed by Thiru. M. Gunasekaran at R.S. No. 19/4, Ward B, Block No. 5, Singaravelar Salai, Karaikalmedu, Thalatheru Village, Karaikal – for enhancement of production capacity.

This proposal of Thiru. M. Gunasekaran for setting up of an Ice Plant in the name and style M/s. Sea mate Ice Plant at R.S. No. 19/4, Ward B, Block No. 5, Singaravelar Salai, Karaikalmedu, Thalatheru Village, Karaikal was discussedin the 27th PCZMA meeting held on 07.11.2012 and was cleared with following condition among others:

- The applicant has obtained permission from Pondicherry State Ground Water Authority to transport 4000 LPD from PASIC Tube Well at T.R. Pattinam (Mela Vanjoor) vide certificate dt. 06.09.2011. Accordingly, the installed production capacity of the unit shall be restricted to 4000 LPD water consumption only.
- ii) The Electricity Department shall restrict the power supply based on the proposed production capacity of the unit (i.e. 4000 LPD only).

Accordingly the proposal was recommended to Karaikal Planning Authority vide letter dated 05.02.2013.

Now the applicant has requested to enhance the production capacity to 10,000 LPD water consumption. The applicant has obtained permission from Pondicherry Ground Water Authority for transport of 10,000 LPD water through authorized water suppliers from PASIC tube well at Vanjur.
