- The proponent has already provided two borewell in the premise of the guest house for in-house usage and gardening.
- The PPA vide its letter no:1044/PPA/Z(SB/ACP)/ 2016/5597 dated 01.12.2016 addressed to Thiru Raj De Condappa, the reproduced version is briefed below:
 - i. it is mentioned in the PPA letter that the proponent shall obtain NOC from the PCZMA since the site falls within the 200-500 metre from HTL.
 - ii. Swimming pool has been constructed without obtaining prior permission from authority i.e. PPA.
- As per the CRZ Notification 2011, there is restriction of putting bore well and drawl of water from it in the CRZ area)
- The construction of hotels or beach resorts permissible in CRZ-III area as per CRZ Notification, 2011 subject to the conditions as specified in the guidelines at Annexure-III.
- The sanctioning authority is the MoEF&CC for the beach resorts or hotels.
- Considering the above violation, the proposal is placed for discussion.
