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1. Minutes of previous meeting held on 7.11.2008 was approved
2. The Member Secretary informed that Puducherry Power Corporation Limited has asked for convenient date for site visit at Yanam. It was resolved by mutual consultation that the visit can be arranged between 29th, 30th and 31st of August 2009.
3. The Fishing Harbour Project "Construction of Fishing Harbour at Yanam" was presented before the committee. After deliberation the committee finalized the TOR.
4. The Project of Sri Venkateshwara Medical College Hospital and Research Centre was presented before the Committee. It was asked to prepare a comprehensive compliance report on the following points.

- a. The Conditional approval given by PPCC for consideration in the SEAC.
- b. The Committee suggested the revision of rapid EIA including the seven suggestions given by the members

- i) RAPID EIA to be ^{revised} ~~carried out again~~ and to be submitted as per norms ^{with the amendments as follows:}
- ii) Reject of RO- not to be disposed in public drain as TDS is 4000 mg/L > 2100 mg/L, Norms of TDS is only \leq 2100 mg/L
- iii) Risk Assessment to be carried out in detail for Biomedical facility and Boilers
- iv) Toxic compounds, phenol, aromatic compounds (from biomedical labs) in combined stream of sewage need to be analyzed before and after treatment and remedial measures need to be detailed out.
- v) Rainwater Harvesting capacity is to be mentioned
- vi) In proposed green belt, planting of indigenous species are recommended instead of exotic species such as acacia, eucalyptus, etc which are considered to be biological borewells.
- vii) Compare the quantity of water utilizing with that of water conserving through rain water harvest.

- c. Spot inspection of the institute is fixed on 5.08.2009 to verify the compliance of the institute on the NOC issued by the PPCC.
