<u>Report about Observance of National Science Day 2025 at</u> <u>Dr. Abdul Kalam Science Centre and Planetarium on 28.02.2025</u>

National Science Day 2025 was observed in a fitting manner on 28.02.2025 at Dr. Abdul Kalam Science Centre and Planetarium, Puducherry. Every year National Science Day is celebrated on February 28th to commemorate the discovery of the Raman Effect by Indian physicist Sir C.V. Raman in 1928. Staffs of PCS&T and students honoured the statue of Sir C.V. Raman laid at the centre. The theme for National Science Day 2025 was **'Empowering Indian Youth for Global Leadership in Science & Innovation for Viksit Bharat'**.

On this occasion, PCS&T conducted Quiz Competition for the school students Category I (VI to VIII Std) and Category II (IX to XII Std) on the observance of National Science Day – 2025 at Dr. AKSCP.
