## Annual Report of PCZMA for the period August 2011 to March 2012

The Central Government in the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) issued the Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ) Notification, 1991 vide S.O. 114(E) dated the 19<sup>th</sup> February 1991 imposing restrictions on industries, operations and processes in the Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ), keeping in view the importance of the coastal environment and the need to protect the coastal ecosystems from the pressures of developmental activities. The Puducherry Coastal Zone Management Authority (PCZMA) is responsible for implementing the said Notification in the U.T. All developmental activities in CRZ require prior clearance of competent authority (MoEF / PCZMA) under this Notification. In order to further strengthen this Notification a new Coastal Regulation Zone Notification, 2011 has been published by MoEF on 06.01.2011 replacing the Coastal Regulation Zone Notification, 1991.

### **CRZ Violations / Directions issued:**

An unauthorized construction activity was carried out by Sri Aurobindo Ashram Trust at the Ashram Play Ground located along the seaward side of Goubert Avenue in the area falling under CRZ – II without obtaining the permission required under CRZ Notification. The work involved conversion of AC sheet of the existing single storied building into RCC roof. In this connection Puducherry Planning Authority has been addressed to issue suitable direction under the provisions of Puducherry Town and Country Planning Act and Rules and Byelaws made there under vide letter dated 23.03.2012 to M/s. Sri Aurobindo Ashram Trust.

#### **Other Activities:**

- i) A proposal has been sent to Ministry of Environment and Forests, GOI for reconstitution of Puducherry Coastal Zone Management Authority vide letter dated 07.10.2011 as the tenure of the existing composition of the existing composition of PCZMA was over by August, 2011.
- ii) **International Coastal Clean up Day 2011 was c**elebrated on 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2011 in collaboration with Local Administration Department and other Line Departments. A massive coastal cleanup activity was organized along the coastal stretch of Puducherry Region. An amount of Rs. 81,990/- was spent by PPCC for organizing the Programme.
- iii) The initiatives to implement the World Bank Funded Integrated Coastal Zone Management (ICZM) Project of MoEF in Puducherry continued this year. A consultation Meeting was held on 19.07.2011 under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary and it was decided that Proposals have been invited from various line Departments to to discuss the priorities and components to be included in the ICZM Project for Puducherry U.T. The Feasibility Report is being prepared in consultation with the line Departments.
