The Committee heard the proposal of the project agency and discussed the subject in detail. The Committee after due deliberation decided to clear the proposal with the following conditions:

The Committee heard the proposal of the project agency and discussed the subject in detail. The Committee after due deliberation decided to refer the proposal to the Regional Committee of State Ground Water Authority for their clearances first.

Agenda Item No. 4: Issue of Consent to Establish to M/s. Sri Mahalakshmi Ice Plant, at R.S. No. 51/3/26, 51/3/27, 51/3/28, Patta No. 361, Gandhi Salai, Keezhaiyur South, T. R. Pattinam Commune, Karaikal for manufacturing White Ice – 30 T/D.

The Committee heard the proposal of the project agency and discussed the subject in detail. The Committee after due deliberation decided to clear the proposal with the following conditions:
