**MINUTES OF THE 176th MEETING OF PUDUCHERRY POLLUTION CONTROL
COMMITTEE HELD ON 22.02.2023 AT 4.00 P.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL,
CHIEF SECRETARIAT, PUDUCHERRY**

Agenda Item No. I – Confirmation of the Minutes of 175th PPCC Meeting held on 02.11.2022.

Agenda Item No. II–Cases for Issue of Consent to Establish

Agenda Item No. 1: Issue of Consent to Establish to M/s. Kals Breweries Pvt Ltd (IMFL – Blending and Bottling Unit), R.S. No. 37/1, 37/3, 38/1, 38/2, 39/1, Vazhudavur Main Road, Ayyankuttipalayam, Kurumbapet, Villianur Commune, Puducherry for blending and bottling of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL).

The committee heard the proposal of the project agency and discussed the subject in detail. The committee noted that the proposal is sister concern of M/s. Kals Breweries Pvt Ltd (Brewery Unit). The committee also noted that the water requirement of the new proposal would be met out from already permitted quantity of ground water. Trade effluent generated is proposed to be treated in existing ETP of Brewery Unit. The Committee after deliberation decided to defer the proposal and directed to:

- i) Verify the compliance status of consent conditions and discharge standards of treated effluent to ensure the efficiency of performance of the ETP.
- ii) Submit detailed Water Balance for brewery and IMFL unit indicating withdrawal of ground water consumption, treatment and reuse.

Agenda Item No. 2: Issue of Consent to Establish / NOC to M/s. SNJ Distillers Pvt Ltd, R.S.No. 10/1, 10/3/A, 3/1, 3/2, 3/3/A-G, 3/4/A-F, Thondamāntham, Villianur Commune, Puducherry for blending and bottling of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL).

The committee heard the proposal of the project agency and discussed the subject in detail. The Committee after deliberation decided to defer the proposal and directed to obtain:

- i) Views of Puducherry Ground Water Authority for feasibility of extraction of ground water in the proposed site as Member Secretary of Puducherry Ground Water Authority who was invited as Special Invitee did not attend the meeting.
- ii) Submit detailed Water Balance indicating withdrawal, consumption, treatment and reuse.

Agenda Item 3: Issue of NOC / CTE to M/s Sri Manakula Vinayagar Educational Trust for Construction of Super Specialty Hospital in the existing M/s Sri Manakula Vinayagar Medical College campus at Kalitheerthalkuppam, Madagadipet, Mannadipet Commune, Puducherry.

The Committee heard the proposal of the issue of CTE to the Medical College, for Construction of Super Specialty Hospital in the existing campus of M/s Sri Manakula Vinayagar Medical College. The Committee after due deliberation decided to clear the proposal and issue CTE for the proposed expansion with the following conditions:

- i) The unit shall not draw any more additional ground water than already permitted water quantity of 740 KLD.
- ii) Maximum reuse of treated waste water shall be explored and the proponent shall quantify the rain water recharge capacity of the Health Care Facility.
- iii) The unit shall maintain proper log books for the water consumption and the same shall be submitted once in 3 months to PPCC.
- iv) The unit shall comply with all the conditions of Environmental Clearance obtained from the SEIAA, dated 31.01.2017.
- v) Agreement entered with CBMWTF shall be revised in order to dispose bio medical waste generated from the additional 680 beds, before establishment of the Super Speciality hospital.
- vi) Proponent shall apply for Consent To Operate before operating 680 additional beds.

Agenda Item No. 4: Issue of Consent to Establish (Expansion) to M/s. Ganges Internationale Pvt Ltd, Sedarapet, Villianur Commune, Puducherry for enhancement of production capacity.

The committee heard the proposal of the project agency and discussed the subject in detail. The Committee after deliberation decided to clear the proposal with the following conditions:

- i) Spent Acid, Zinc ash and dross generated shall be disposed to SPCB / PPCC authorized recyclers or Common Effluent Treatment Plant located in adjacent States.
- ii) The unit shall provide STP for treatment of sewage generated.
- iii) Necessary fume extract system with duct and hood connected to the stack of 30 m height shall be provided.

Agenda Item No. 5: Issue of CTE to M/s. Kals Distilleries Private Limited, a Large Scale, Orange Category unit, for setting up of a Blending and Bottling of IMFL unit, at, R.S. No. 289/4, 289/2, 290/3, 291/14, Nedungadu Revenue Village, Karaikal.

The Committee heard the proposal of the Project Agency in detail. The Committee noted that the proposal involves drawal of 45 KLD of ground water. The Committee after due deliberation decided to defer the proposal and get views of the Puducherry Ground Water Authority for drawal of 45 KLD of ground water as Member Secretary of Puducherry Ground Water Authority who was invited as Special Invitee did not attend the meeting.

Agenda Item No. 6: Issue of CTE to M/s. Chemplast Sanmar Ltd., a Large Scale, Red (17 Categories) unit, for replacement of existing Caustic Concentration Unit (CCU) with a new one of the same capacity and replacement of existing 500 KVA DG Set with a New 600 KVA DG Set.

The Committee heard the proposal of the Project Agency in detail. The proposal involves replacement of existing Caustic Concentration Unit (CCU) installed in 1996 with new one of same capacity. Also, the existing 500 KVA DG Set installed in 1986 which is not in working condition is proposed to be replaced with 600-KVA DG Set. There is no production enhancement or additional water and power requirement. The Committee after due deliberation decided to clear the proposal subject to the following conditions:

- i) There shall be no any production enhancement or additional water and power requirement.
- ii) The project proponent shall submit complete material and energy balance for the new CCU unit and the old CCU unit and shall ensure that the proposed new CCU is energy efficient
- iii) The proposed new DG Set of 600 KVA capacity shall be installed with Retrofit Emission Control Devices.
- iv) For other existing DG Sets listed below, the project proponent shall not operate them until the Retrofit Emission Control Devices are installed as per the "*System and Procedure For Emission Compliance Testing of Retro-fit Emission Control Devices (RECD) For Diesel Power Generating Set Engines Up to Gross Mechanical Power 800 kW*" report of CPCB dated 01.02.2022.

Agenda Item No. 7: Issue of NOC / CTE to M/s JIPMER's Multi Speciality Hospital consulting unit, Yanam.

The Committee heard the proposal of issue of CTE to M/s JIPMER's Multi Speciality Hospital consulting unit, Yanam. The Committee after due deliberation decided to clear the proposal and issue CTE for the proposed Project with the following conditions:

- (i) The proponent shall install 50 KLD STP and 5 KLD STP.
- (ii) For establishing the 50 KLD STP in Kamal Nehru Girls High School, Yanam, a buffer zone between the school & STP shall be established for control of odour & noise pollution.
- (iii) Agreement shall be entered with M/s EVB Technologies, Rajamundry in order to treat bio medical waste generated from the proposed hospital, before commencement of the Activity.
- (iv) Proponent shall apply for Consent to Operate before operating the facility.

- 1. Member of the committee emphasized need of utilization of waste plastic in road making. The committee recommended to utilize plastic waste in road making by PWD and LAD.
