SOLAR ENTERPRISE ASSISTANT MANAGER (NSQF Level: 5)
Under Green Skill Development Programme of
Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India

In alignment with the Skill India Mission, the Hon'ble Prime Minister has launched the Green Skill Development Programme (GSDP) through the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India. Under this initiative, a certificate course on “**Solar Enterprise Assistant Manager**” is being conducted by the EIACP Hub of the Puducherry Pollution Control Committee (PPCC), Government of Puducherry.

It comprises both theoretical and practical classes designed to strengthen foundational knowledge on installation, operation and maintenance of solar plants, alongside field visits and hands-on training. This course will enhance candidates' entrepreneurial skills and readiness.

There is **no fee for the course**. Candidates from outside Puducherry region will be provided free lodging and boarding during the course. Only candidates who meet the eligibility criteria will be considered for selection through the selection process which may include an interview.
