Notice Inviting Quotation

Puducherry Pollution Control Committee intends to enter into a Rate Contract for Ambient Air Quality Monitoring and Analysis of metal parameters in the exposed filter papers on the occasion of Diwali festival for a period of two years with effect from 1st November, 2026. Hence, it is requested to submit the quote for the parameters detailed in the annexure and as per the terms & conditions enclosed herewith.

The Quotation should be submitted in a sealed envelope. The title for quotation, i.e., **“Quotation for rate contract towards the Ambient Air Quality Monitoring and Metal analysis on the occasion of Diwali festival”** must be written on the top of the envelope and addressed to the Member Secretary, Puducherry Pollution Control Committee. The quotation should reach this office on or before **07.08.2026**.

Subject to selection, after executing the assigned work, necessary analytical report along with the bill may be furnished in favour of the Member Secretary, Puducherry Pollution Control Committee for settlement of payment.

ANNEXURE

24 HRS CONTINUOUS 15 DAYS AMBIENT AIR QUALITY MONITORING AND ANALYSIS ON THE OCCASION OF DIWALI FESTIVAL

AMBIENT AIR QUALITY MONITORING:

Note: PM₁₀ – 3 samples/24hrs; PM_{2.5} – 1 sample/24hrs; SO₂ and NO₂ – 6 samples/24 hrs

ANALYSIS OF AIR POLLUTANTS:

Sl. No.	AAQ Metal Analysis	Amount (in Rs.) per location
1.	Lead, Arsenic and Nickel in EPM 2000 filter paper (3 samples per day) (15 days x 1 location x 3 samples = 45 samples)	
2.	Aluminum, Barium and Iron in 2.5 micron filter papers per sample/day (15 days x 1 location x 1 samples = 15 samples)	

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. The lab should have valid MoEF recognition/ NABL Accreditation. The above mentioned parameters should be covered in the scope.
2. A copy of the Certificate and Scope of recognition under EP Act, 1986 / accredited by NABL shall be submitted along with the quote.
3. Quotation should be typed. The bidder/agency must sign each page of the quotation, including the final page, as an acknowledgment of acceptance of all terms and conditions outlined therein.
4. Quote and terms of reference shall be clear without overwriting and corrections.
5. The rates quoted should be inclusive of all charges i.e., transport, taxes etc.,
6. The rate quoted by the firm should be valid for a period of two years with effect from 1st November, 2026.
7. Ambient Air Quality Monitoring shall be conducted at the locations identified by PPCC for 24 hours on the occasion of Diwali festival.
8. Calibrated PM₁₀ and PM_{2.5} Samplers with their own manpower shall be used for conduct of monitoring.
9. Standby instruments should also be available at the monitoring locations.
10. The firm shall place the monitoring instrument at the site one day prior to the monitoring.
11. For conduct of the said monitoring, required filter papers and reagents will be supplied by PPCC only.

12. It is the duty and responsibility of the firm to collect the required filter papers and reagents for monitoring from the laboratory of DST&E/PPCC at Mettupalayam.
13. The firm shall hand over the exposed filter papers and gaseous samples for analysis along with required data of the instrument on the subsequent day before 10.00 AM at the laboratory without fail. The filter paper will be returned for metal analysis. The firm should submit the metal analysis report within a week. The firm should store the digested sample for 28 days for repeatability test required if any.
14. The electricity charges claimed by the owner of the monitoring location shall be paid by the firm.
15. Required amount will be deducted in case if the monitoring station is not operated.
16. The bidder will be responsible for all legal consequences and liabilities arising out of lapses or negligence on his part (including material and manpower).
17. The test report shall be submitted in time strictly. If the firm fail to monitor, submit the report in time and to follow the terms & conditions, the contract with the firm will be cancelled and the next lowest rate quoted firm will be assigned the rate contract for executing the requirements.
18. Payment will be made to the bidder after execution of each assigned work satisfactorily.
19. Bills will be settled after ensuring the above terms & conditions are satisfactorily fulfilled by selected firm.
20. The Member Secretary, Puducherry Pollution Control Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the quotations without assigning any reason thereof.
